Rules 2011

CHAMPAGNE-ARDENNE YOUTH OPEN

ARTICLE 1 : Eligibility

The event is reserved for the following associations and delegations: regional associations, foreign national and regional associations and clubs.

Champagne-Ardenne Youth Open will be played in 8 single categories, from which the individual results will be taken for 2 team's ranking (Team's Challenges). No obligation to participate in Team's Challenge is required to participate in the individual events. One player can participate in his age category event and/or in the age category one level higher.

ARTICLE 2 : Events

8 events for 4 age categories will be organized :

- 9 years old boys (born in 2002 or later)
- 9 years old girls (born in 2002 or later)
- 11 years old boys (born in 2000 or 2001)
- 11 years old girls (born in 2000 or 2001)
- 13 years old boys (born in 1998 or 1999)
- 13 years old girls (born in 1998 or 1999)
- 15 years old boys (born 1996 or 1997)
- 15 years old girls (born in 1996 or 1997)

The age categories are fixed according to ITTF age categories up to the dates of the event.

ARTICLE 3 : Entry fee

The accreditation for players is fixed on **10 EUR per event** or it is included in the official hospitality package. For participation in the second event the additional fee of **8 EUR** will be required. In total 18 EUR for the accreditation in 2 events or an additional fee of 8 EUR to the official hospitality package.

ARTICLE 4 : Challenges

The Team's Challenge will take place in every tournament edition.

Every delegation can take part in the Team's Challenge with at least one player in each of 4 event's categories with at least one girl and one boy.

The ranking for that Challenge will be taken from the 4 best results in each of 4 different events. The players of the youngest category (born 2002 and later) will get an extra bonus for their results.

The winner of the Team's Challenge will be awarded with cash price money 500 EUR.

The Girls Team's Challenge will take place in every tournament edition.

Every delegation can take part in the Girls Challenge with at least 3 girls participating in at least 2 categories.

The ranking for the Girls Challenge will be taken from the 3 best results in at least 2 different events.

The winner of the Team's Challenge will be awarded with cash price money 500 EUR.

ARTICLE 5 : Entries

The preliminary and final entries have to be sent and confirmed by the delegations.

Each delegation may enter a maximum of 2 players in each event.

The list of participants with **the first and second name, date of birth and the ranking of every player according to the last ranking issue** has to be sent to the organization committee 15 days before the start of the competition.

ARTICLE 6 : Financial part

Travel and hospitality costs and entree fees are at the costs of the participating delegation.

The official hospitality packages are proposed in the attached file.

ARTICLE 7 : Umpires and referees

Each delegation has to provide one umpire per team on their costs. The umpire has to be in disposition of the main referee during whole event.

In case of disregard of this article you will be charged with a 50 € penalty.

All the matches will be played with an umpire.

ARTICLE 8 : Playing systems

8.1 Due to the number of preliminary entries each event is limited by a number of 48 players.

8.2 First stage of each event will be played in the groups.

8.3 Second stage will be played in a progressive knock-out system up to determine a final ranking for each player.

8.4 At least 5 matches are guaranteed per player per one event.

ARTICLE 9 : Match system

Every event and every match of the events will be played best of 5 games.

ARTICLE 10 : System of the Team's Challenge

All teams following to the terms of article 4 may participate in the Team's Challenge of Champagne-Ardenne Junior Open.

10.1 For each team only the best result per event will be taken for the final team's ranking.

10.2 The 4 best individual results of the team will be taken for the final team's ranking.

10.3 Each of these 4 results give the team the number of points equivalent to the place of the player in the event. There is a bonus of -1 point for the youngest category (born in 2002 and later).

Example: 1st in the category of 2002 and younger = 0 points, 2nd in 2002 and younger = 1 point etc...

1st in the category of 2000/1998/1996 = 1 point, 2nd in 2000/1998/1996 = 2 points etc.

10.4 The number of points obtained by a team is the total amount of points achieved by its 4 representatives.

10.5 The ranking is made by the amount of points achieved; the team with the least points will be the winner.

10.6 In case of an equal number of points the ranking will be ruled as followed:

a) first we will judge by the best individual result, followed by the second best individual result, etc.

b) second we will reward to youngest player of the teams 4 participants

ARTICLE 11 : System of the Girls Team's Challenge

All teams following to the terms of article 4 may participate in the Team's Challenge of Champagne-Ardenne Junior Open.

11.1 For each team, the 3 best female results will be counted in at least 2 different events.

11.2 The team's ranking will be based on the best 3 results.

11.3 Each of these 3 results give the team the number of points equivalent to the place of the player in the event . (1st = 1point, 2nd= 2points etc...)

- 11.4 The number of points obtained by a team is the total amount of points achieved by its 3 representatives.
- 11.5 The ranking is made by the amount of points achieved; the team with the least points will be the winner.
- 11.6 In case of an equal number of points the ranking will be ruled as followed:
a) first we will reward the best individual result, followed by the second best individual result, etc.
b) second we will reward to youngest player of the teams 4 participants.

ARTICLE 12 : Jury d'appel

The current rules can be changed by the main referee if necessary. For each sportive responsibility, a jury can be formed. This jury will include the president of the league Champagne-Ardenne or its representative, the main referee and the general commissioner of the organization.

ARTICLE 13 : Awards

The welcome package will be given to all members of delegations and all players.

Awards for the single events

- 1st places - cups, medals and gifts vouchers for the table tennis equipment
- 2nd places - cups and medals
- 3rd and 4th places - medals

Awards for the team results

The winner of the Team's Challenge will get price money 500 EUR and Trophy.

The winner of the Girls Team's Challenge will get price money 500 EUR , Trophy and flowers.

Delegation with the most representatives will get a Magnum of Champagne and Trophy of the city Charleville-Mézières.

Accommodation and Catering

The organizing club CMATT proposes two different packages (A or B) for two different lengths of stay (1 or 2).

Important: both packages include the registration for one event of the competition. A fee of 8 € will be asked for the registration of the player to a 2nd event.

Package A:

- Accommodation in rooms of 4 people maximum in a high school located 2 km from the competition hall. (If possible, the number of persons by room can be modified according to the wishes of the teams)
- The lunch is served on the place of the competition and the dinners and breakfasts are served in the high school.
- The bed sheets are not provided. However, a limited number of bed sheets are available for a 2 € fee.

Package B:

- Accommodation in double-room in Campanile hotel 2* located 5 km from the competition hall.
- The lunch is served on the place of the competition and the dinners and breakfasts are served in the hotel.

Only lunch:

You may take the lunch in the competition hall for 12 €.

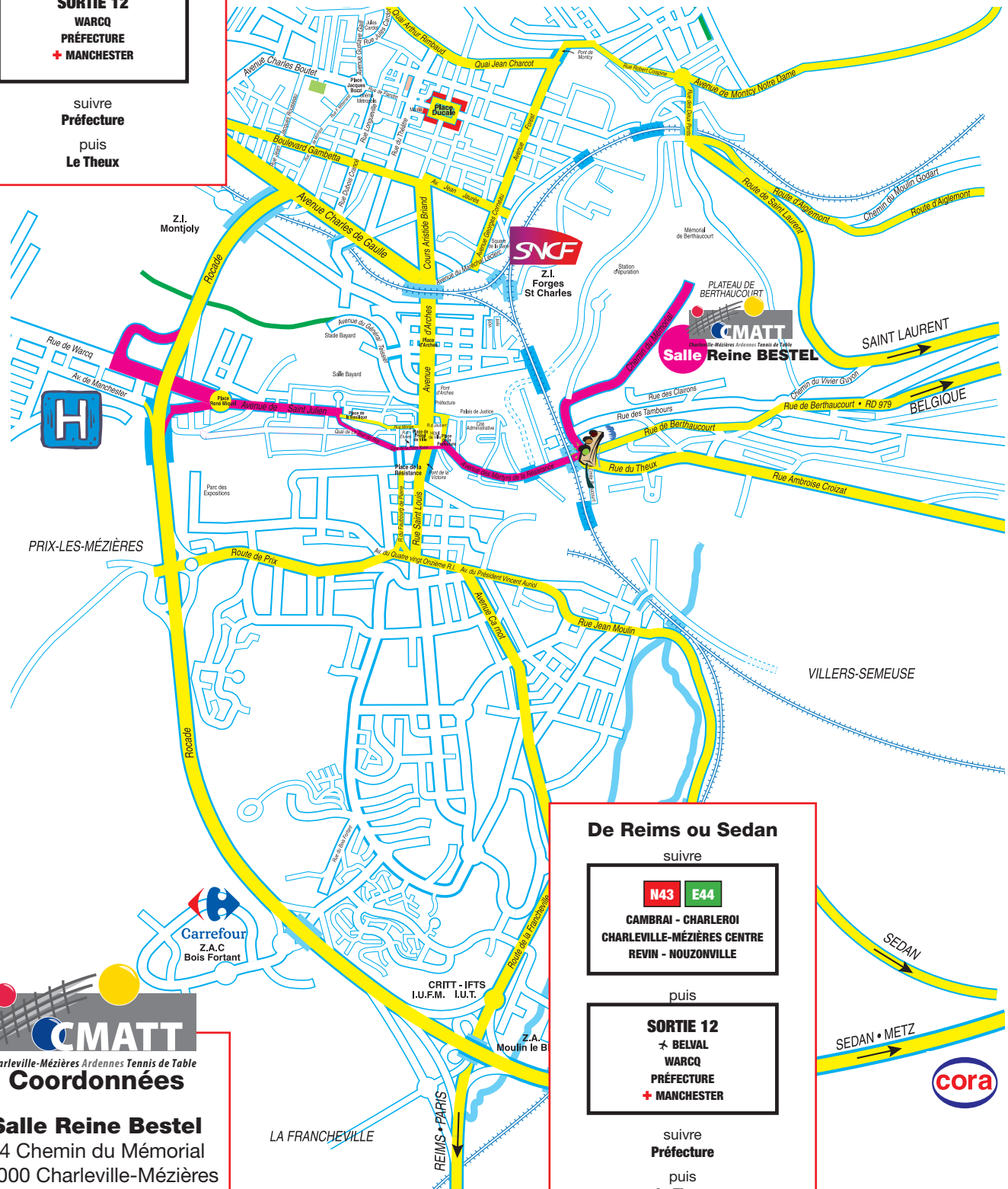
